**HENREDON PUTS SOPHISTICATED SPIN ON
ACQUISITIONS COLLECTION**

Chic, Refined Designs Bring New Look to Old Favorite

High Point, NC (October 15, 2010)—Henredon brings a fresh, designer look to its highly successful *Acquisitions by Henredon* collection at the fall High Point Market. Twenty new designs add urbane sophistication and sizzle to this diverse family of furniture.

Launched in the spring of 2002, the assortment of accents includes a mélange of designs reflecting various historical periods and styles—giving consumers the opportunity to create their own design direction from one special collection.

“With *Acquisitions*, you can update or transform a room with a single dynamic piece without changing the entire décor,” says Dan Bradley, Henredon president.

The latest additions fit seamlessly into the existing *Acquisitions* portfolio and can be intermixed for a collected-over-time look. New this market are chests, nightstand, bench, dining table, server, dining chair, console, bookcase, occasional tables, and an engaging arched wooden bed.

Like the original offering, the new designs draw from such diverse backgrounds as Asian, French Country, Regency, Classical French, and Chippendale, among others. Aged iron, reeded tambours, and accent finishes spark the collection.

“One reason *Acquisitions* is so popular is that ‘eclectic’ has become the dominate decorating style,” says Bradley. “There’s no question that the ‘suited up’ look has given way to a looser mix-and-match attitude. As a result, item buying is now the trend.”

Because the unique items in *Acquisitions* are not necessarily tied to a particular style or era, they can move about the home performing whatever role is scripted. These special designs can fill nooks and crannies, or be the one eye-riveting piece that takes center stage.

While each new *Acquisitions* piece is outstanding, a few are worthy of special note. First is a spectacular panel bed crafted of figured mahogany with a horizontal harlequin shaped ebony inlay at its crown. Reminiscent of Regency styling, the bed is refined and regal, exhibiting a gracefully curved silhouette. A clean-lined double dresser and Oriental inspired nightstand on high stepping metal legs cozy up to the bed.

The new *Acquisitions* dining table evokes County French styling with its turned legs and hand-planed top. The accompanying server takes more of a Classical French approach; as does the traditional neo-classical dining chair. Adhering to no particular style category is a tambour-door credenza, which can function as server or TV stand.

Among the unique occasional pieces is a 3-step tier table with open Chippendale fretwork sides. The ingenious design works equally well as night stand or end table. Rounding out the offerings is an imaginatively conceived bookcase perfect for housing books, TV, or computer.

Acquisitions by Henredon gives style conscious consumers and savvy designers an assortment of imaginative accents to spice up their interiors. "With these additions, the continued success of the collection is assured," declared Bradley.
