BROYHILL INTRODUCES GLUCKSTEINHOME COLLECTIONS

HIGH POINT, NC – October 22, 2011 – Broyhill Furniture is introducing collections designed by Brian Gluckstein, international interior designer and founder of both GlucksteinDesign and Gluckstein Home. GlucksteinHome, launched in 1999, focuses on affordable home furnishings which reflect the luxurious, yet functional appeal of Brian’s work and tie in perfectly with the focus of Broyhill Furniture.

The groups are themed on distinct design characteristics: *Antiquity*, which he describes as a modern approach to traditional elements; *Hampton*, featuring relaxed tones and casual silhouettes at the beach; *Suede*, a celebration of deep tones and rich textures with a Zen-like serenity.

Antiquity

Traditionally designed with contemporary elements, the Antiquity collection features ribbon mahogany and hardwood solids throughout with a deep velvet finish, revealing highs and lows in the veneers. The five-piece bedroom includes a sleigh bed. The dining room includes a four-column pedestal table accented with metal caps (extending to 96” with 18” leaf). The dining chairs feature a Chippendale-inspired design on the chair backs and the server gleams with an antique mirror front. Five occasional tables are in this group, including a cocktail table featuring an antique mirror top and a casted end table with a removable tray.

Hampton

A casually refined collection, Hampton is formed of quartered oak veneers and rubberwood solids in a light mocha stain with putty colored glaze accents. The bedroom offers five pieces and a choice of two beds, including a dramatic canopy bed. The dining room is simple yet dramatic, with a double pedestal dining table (extending to 92” with 18” leaf). A sideboard and upholstered arm and side chairs complete the dining room. Occasional tables feature unique style elements such as leather fronted drawers, antique pewter metal frames and removable trays – available in four styles.

Suede

Featuring beautiful medium brown cathedral walnut veneers and hardwood solids, the Suede collection creates a sense of balance with use of framing and open compartments. Highlights in the five-piece bedroom include a panel bed with a wrap headboard. The dining room features a trestle table (extending to 96” with an 18” leaf), a sideboard and chairs with upholstered seats. Occasional tables include a lamp table with marble top and two end tables.

Brian Gluckstein is internationally known for his sophisticated interiors and award-winning commercial and residential design projects. Since launching his interior design career over two decades ago, Gluckstein has been celebrated for his effortless style and talent for mixing timeless pieces with forward-looking design.
